<p>Guatemala: Esquipulas, our home base, is a small city. Primary Care Team rides in back bed of a truck daily to rural mountain villages outside Esquipulas.</p> <p>Haiti: Gros Morne, in the north, is our home base. Primary Care Team rides in the back bed of a truck daily to rural sites</p> <p>Jamaica: Kingston, The Primary Care Team travels by van each day to inner-city communities of Kingston and to rural settings along the southern coast.</p>	<p>All Primary Care Programs:</p> <p>Include family and community medicine, pediatrics and GYN, along with Pharmacy, PT and OT. MH, may be included.</p> <p>All teams also need persons with skills other than clinical skills. (Interpreters, Logistics: Supply Team; Teachers, Data input, General Support Services)</p>	<p>Education Program:</p> <p>Depending on the topics identified by our in- country partners and the bilingual expertise of our volunteers, we may provide educational seminars for community volunteers, professional and para-professionals in each country we serve. Topics include: Chronic Disease Management, Maternal-Child Health, STDs, Hygiene, Wound Care, Eye Care, and Body Mechanics.</p>

<p>Peru: Chulucanas, a city in Northern Peru is our home base and primary clinic site. Most of the team provides care in Chulucanas, on or close to the same campus where the team stays. A few team members may travel and stay in mountain villages where they set up "clinic".</p> <p>The surgery program utilizes the general hospital in Chulucanas.</p>	<p>Primary Care Program: Same as above</p> <p>Surgery Program: General & Vascular, OB/GYN, and Plastics, and Podiatry. Ophthalmology or ENT Surgery may be included depending on resources and staff. Bio-Med Staff are always needed. Surgeons and Anesthesia Providers and O.R. Staff (Scrub / Circulating) for Pediatric as well as Adult Surgery are especially needed.</p>	<p>Primary Care Team: Same as above.</p> <p>Surgery Program: Education other than one-on-one during Pre/Post OP depends on resources, demand and OR schedule each year.</p>

Please do not try to upload and send us a photo of your passport or other documents. Uploaded photos become distorted in internet or faxed transmission. They are not able to be clearly read and often rejected by the country.

If you are connected to a Trinity Health ministry and/or CHS, Buffalo or a BayCare Ministry, please inform the Mission Leader BEFORE you send this application. Also, please verify with your supervisor that you will have the necessary PTO time. We are a member of / affiliate of these organizations and follow their policies & procedures. Trinity Health Regional Health Ministries may have a pre-application process for colleagues in their organizations.

Some Regional Health Ministries of Trinity Health provide some form of support for colleagues participating on a **Global Health Volunteers** Mission because **Global Health Volunteers is the official international volunteer program of Trinity Health** system. Ask your Mission Leader if any support is available for GHV team members.

Volunteer Time Requirements:

Pre-Trip: All accepted applicants are expected to participate in the scheduled Orientation.

Orientation materials provide information that answer most questions you may have, including what you need to do pre-trip, where you will be staying and working, what to bring, etc. Flight options and travel plans as well as expenses and fund raising are also discussed.

Traveling: **All team members** are expected to arrive in the country within the assigned time so that everyone can clear customs within the designated 24 hour time period. Persons wishing to add "tourist" time to their mission should do so **after the mission** and never before the mission. We need every team member to carry mission supplies to the country, so you need to go through customs with the Global Health team when Health Office officials are there specifically for our team. Also, you need to arrive at the final destination to be with the team on transport arranged for the team.

Responsibility for Finances and Supplies – Do not let cost keep you from applying. Some grant funding is available. Also, we provide fundraising ideas and materials to help volunteers.

***Program Costs: Paid to GHM:** covers, housing, food, ground transport, security, travel insurance, and a contribution toward the cost of medical services provided to our patients, including follow-up care. A “Registration Fee” of \$50 required at Orientation is included in the above program cost amount.

Airfare Costs are based on current rates and are fairly unpredictable – Cost depends on your home base.

Additional Personal Expenses vary per person covering: Meals during international travel, Day Off expenses, laundry expense, and personal purchases.

MANY TEAMS ARE FILLED 6 MONTHS BEFORE THE MISSION, SO DO NOT DELAY APPLYING !

However, there is NO DEADLINE for applications. All positions are filled on a first-come, first-chosen basis among those who are equally qualified, with priority consideration given to those connected to Trinity Health, BayCare, CHS, or one of our long-term partner organizations, including Mercy Medical Center (Baltimore, MD), First-Hand Foundation.

Most NEW applicants are contacted to participate in a 30 minute telephone conversation.

Every effort will be made to make sure that all applicants receive notice of their status as soon as possible. Those chosen for a team will be notified by email and receive Orientation information.
